PART II

SCALE OF COMPENSATION FOR EXTINGUISHMENT OF MANORIAL INCIDENTS.

Timber.

Compensation for timber shall be ascertained as follows:—Where by a special custom of the manor the lord can enter upon the land, and cut and carry away the timber -without the consent of the tenant, its whole value, after making a sufficient allowance for repairs, shall be given to the lord. But where there is no special custom, so that the ordinary law of copyholds is applicable and therefore the lord cannot enter and cut without the consent of the tenant, one half only of its value, after making a sufficient allowance for repairs, shall be given. If there be any other special custom in the manor relating to timber, such custom shall be regarded.
