

Allotments Act 1922

1922 CHAPTER 51 12 and 13 Geo 5

5 Rights of tenant who has paid compensation to outgoing tenant.

Where a tenant of an allotment has paid compensation to an outgoing tenant for any fruit trees or bushes or other improvement, he shall have the same rights as to compensation or removal as he would have had under this Act if the fruit trees or bushes had been provided and planted or the improvement had been made by him and at his expense.
