GENERAL PROVISIONS

67 Jurisdiction of the “court.”

- (1) In this Act “the court” means the High Court, . . . ^{F1}, or the county court, where those courts respectively have jurisdiction.
- (2) The procedure under this Act in, . . . ^{F1}^{F2}the county court] shall be in accordance with the Acts and rules regulating the procedure of those courts.
