#### PRELIMINARY

## <sup>F1</sup>10 Crown rights.

Without prejudice to the generality of the provisions of section twelve of the <sup>M1</sup>Public Health Acts Amendment Act 1907, nothing in this Act shall affect . . . <sup>F2</sup> any [<sup>F3</sup>[<sup>F1</sup>electronic communications apparatus kept installed for the purposes of an electronic communications code network] or the execution for those purposes of any works]. . ..
