### 6 Amendment or adaptation of local Acts, &c.

[ $^{FI}$ The Secretary of State] may, by order made on the application of any local authority, make such amendments or adaptations of any local Act as may appear to him to be necessary for the purpose of bringing the provisions of that Act into conformity with the provisions of this Act,  $^{F2}$ . . ..
