14 Provisions as to valuation roll.

(1) Every valuation roll made up in accordance with the ^{M1}Lands Valuation (Scotland) Act, 1854, . . . ^{F1}, shall in addition, to the other particulars required by the said Acts show [^{F2}the net annual value and also,] the rateable value of the lands and heritages . . . ^{F3}, and the provisions of the ^{M2}Lands Valuation (Scotland) Act, 1854 (including, without prejudice to the said generality, the provisions with respect to notices to persons whose property is valued and with respect to appeals) shall apply accordingly.
