



# Sheriff Courts and Legal Officers (Scotland) Act 1927

1927 CHAPTER 35 17 and 18 Geo 5

## PART I

SHERIFF CLERKS, PROCURATORS FISCAL, &C.

### 9 Deputation by sheriff clerk or procurator fiscal.

Notwithstanding anything contained in section two of this Act, it shall be lawful for a sheriff clerk with the consent of the [<sup>F1</sup>Scottish Court Service]<sup>F1</sup>, and for a procurator fiscal with the consent of the Lord Advocate, to grant a deputation to a fit person for whose actings (except in the case where such person is a whole-time clerk) he shall be responsible.
