



Easter Act 1928

1928 CHAPTER 35 18 and 19 Geo 5

PROSPECTIVE

1 Date of Easter-day.

Easter-day shall, in the calendar year next but one after the commencement of this Act and in all subsequent years, be the first Sunday after the second Saturday in April, and section three of the ^{M1}Calendar (New Style) Act 1750, the new calendar, tables and rules annexed to that Act, and section two of the ^{M2}Calendar Act 1751, are hereby amended and shall be read and construed accordingly, . . . ^{F1}
