### 113 Prosecutions and penalties for offences.

- (1) Save as otherwise expressly provided, all offences under this Act shall be prosecuted under the Summary Jurisdiction Acts.
- (2) A person guilty of an offence under this Act . . . <sup>F2</sup> shall be liable in the case of the first offence to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F3</sup>level 2 on the standard scale], and in the case of a second or subsequent conviction, to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months.
