RUNNING OF PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES

108 Interpretation. **E+W+S**

(1) In this Part of this Act—

The expression "local authority" means-

- (i) the council of any \dots ^{F1}[^{F2}district], and
- (ii) any joint board or joint committee which is so constituted as to include among its members representatives of the council of a \dots ^{F1}[^{F2}district]; and

The expression "district" in relation to a joint board or joint committee means the area within which that board or committee are authorised to carry on a tramway, light railway, trolley vehicle or omnibus undertaking and save as aforesaid means a \dots ^{F1}[^{F2}district][^{F3}the area of a council constituted under section 2 of the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994] \dots ^{F1}
