



Church of Scotland (Property and Endowments) (Amendment) Act 1933

1933 CHAPTER 44 23 and 24 Geo 5

18 Interpretation.

In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression “the Church” means the Church of Scotland as now constituted by the Union of the said Church with the United Free Church of Scotland on the second day of October 1929; the expression “The General Assembly” means the General Assembly of the said Church as now so constituted; the expression “the statutory properties and endowments of the parish” has the meaning assigned to it in section thirty-four of the principal Act; the expression “parliamentary church or manse” means any church or manse mentioned in the Tenth Schedule to the principal Act, together with any land whether described as churchyard, glebe or otherwise, connected with any such church or manse; and other expressions have the like meaning as in the principal Act.
