SECOND SCHEDULE

Section 2.

CONSTITUTION AND PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD

- 1 The Board shall consist of such persons as may be appointed by the [^{F1}Prime Minister], and every member of the Board shall hold office for such time as may be specified in his appointment.

- 2 Any person ceasing to be a member of the Board shall be eligible for reappointment.
- 3 If a member of the Board becomes, in the opinion of the [^{F2}Prime Minister], unfit to continue in office or incapable of performing his duties, the [^{F2}Prime Minister] shall forthwith declare his office to be vacant and shall notify the fact in such manner as the [^{F2}Prime Minister] thinks fit, and thereupon the office shall become vacant.
