

Whaling Industry (Regulation) Act 1934

1934 CHAPTER 49

2 Prohibition of catching or treating whales within United Kingdom waters

It shall be unlawful for any ship to be used within the coastal waters of the United Kingdom for taking or treating whales, and if any ship is so used, the master shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months, or to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds, or to both such imprisonment and such fine.
