

Wills (Soldiers and Sailors) Act 1918

1918 CHAPTER 58 7 and 8 Geo 5

4 Power to appoint testamentary guardians.

Where any person dies after the passing of this Act having made a will which is, or which, if it had been a disposition of property, would have been rendered valid by section eleven of the MI Wills Act, 1837, any appointment contained in that will of any person as guardian of the infant children of the testator shall be of full force and effect.
