1919 CHAPTER 50

27 Ability of Minister and secretaries to sit in Parliament

- (1) The office of Minister of Transport, or of secretary in the Ministry of Transport, shall not render the holder thereof incapable of being elected to or sitting or voting as a member of the Commons House of Parliament.
- (2) The person who is first appointed to be Minister shall not by reason of such appointment, if a member of the Commons House of Parliament, vacate his seat as such member.
