



# Land Settlement (Scotland) Act 1919

## PART I

### PROVISIONS AS TO THE ACQUISITION OF LAND

#### **8 Power of entry to inspect land.**

The Board, with a view to ascertaining whether any land is suitable for any purpose for which the Board have power to acquire land, may, by writing in that behalf, authorise any person (upon production if so required of his authority) to enter and inspect the land specified in the authority, and not less than four days' clear notice of any intention so to enter and inspect shall be given by the Board to the landlord or to his agent and to the occupiers of the land, and anyone who obstructs or impedes any person acting under and in accordance with any such authority, after such notice has been given, shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding [<sup>F1</sup>level 2 on the standard scale.]
