7 Amendment of Act of 1924, s. 44.

- (1) Subsection (4) of section forty-four of the Act of 1924 shall be amended as follows, that is to say:—
 - (a) in paragraph (b) thereof the words "section one hundred and three of the ^{MI}Bankruptcy (Scotland) Act, 1856, or of" and the proviso shall be omitted, and for the words "a memorandum in the form provided by the said section forty-four of the said Act of 1913, as amended by this Act, which memorandum being so recorded shall have the effect of a memorandum recorded in terms of the said section forty-four as amended as aforesaid" there shall be substituted the words "a memorandum in the form provided by Schedule 0 to this Act"; and
 - (b) in paragraph (c) thereof there shall be inserted after the words "in such register" the words "or have recorded a memorandum in such register in terms of paragraph (b) of this subsection".
- (2) the Act of 1924 shall be amended by the addition after Schedule N thereto of a schedule in the form contained in the Schedule to this Act.
