

Leasehold Property (Repairs) Act 1938

1938 CHAPTER 34

6 Court having jurisdiction under this Act.

- (1) In this Act the expression "the court" means the county court, except in a case in which any proceedings by action for which leave may be given would have to be taken in a court other than the county court, and means in the said excepted case that other court.
- (2) The County Courts Act, 1934, shall have effect as if this Act had been one of the enactments referred to in subsection (3) of section fifty-two of that Act, and set out in the first column of the Second Schedule to that Act, and as if all cases other than the said excepted case had been mentioned in the second column of that schedule.
