General

22 Appeals and stay of execution.

Subject to the provisions of this Act, all enactments [^{F1}and rules of court]^{F1} relating to appeals and stay of execution shall, with any necessary modification, apply to civil proceedings by or against the Crown as they apply to proceedings between subjects.
