### General

## 22 Appeals and stay of execution.

Subject to the provisions of this Act, all enactments [<sup>F1</sup>and rules of court]<sup>F1</sup> relating to appeals and stay of execution shall, with any necessary modification, apply to civil proceedings by or against the Crown as they apply to proceedings between subjects.
