(1) The sections shall, subject to the modification hereinafter provided, continue in operation in relation to smallholdings sold or let before the commencement of Part IV of this Act, except in so far as they provide for the sale of smallholdings or any other disposition thereof [^{F2} not authorised by Part III of the Agriculture Act 1970] and except in so far as subsection (1) of section six renders the consent of the Minister unnecessary where no contribution is payable by him. (2) The requirement in paragraph (c) of subsection (1) of section six that the holding shall be cultivated in accordance with the rules of good husbandry as defined in the M1
Sections thirteen and fourteen (provisions as to loans for purchase and equipment of holdings).	Agricultural Holdings Act 1923, shall be construed as a requirement that the owner or occupier, as the case may be, shall fulfil his responsibilities to farm the holding in accordance with the rules of good husbandry, and section eleven of this Act shall apply accordingly. The sections shall continue in operation in relation to loans made before the commencement of Part IV of this Act.
