#### PART V

#### LAND SETTLEMENT

Provision of holdings by the Secretary of State

### Power of Secretary of State to provide and equip holdings.

- (1) For the purpose of providing agricultural holdings, being either holdings of which the area does not exceed [FIthirty hectares] or holdings the annual rent of which does not exceed one hundred and fifty pounds, the Secretary of State shall have the like power to acquire land by agreement or compulsorily as he has for the purposes of the MISmall Holding Colonies Acts, 1916 MIS and 1918, and those Acts and Part I of the MISLAND Settlement (Scotland) Act, 1919, shall have effect as if the provision of such agricultural holdings as aforesaid were included among the purposes of the said Acts of 1916 and 1918.
- (2) The Secretary of State shall have, in relation to any land acquired or appropriated by him for the purpose first mentioned in the last foregoing subsection, the like powers of adaptation, equipment and management as he has in relation to land acquired by him for the purpose of providing smallholdings.
