## NINTH SCHEDULE

MINOR AND CONSEQUENTIAL AMENDMENTS.

The Agricultural Holdings (Scotland) Act, 1923.

In section nine (which relates to compensation for the continuous adoption of a special standard or system of farming), in subsection (1) the words " (if any) " shall be omitted; after the words " required by the lease " there shall be inserted the words " or in so far as no system of farming is so required, than the system of farming normally practised on comparable holdings in the district "; in paragraph (a) of the proviso, after the words " record so made " there shall be inserted the words " or, where more than one such record has been made during the tenancy, before the date of the first such record "; and in paragraph (b) of the proviso, after the words " the tenant has " there shall be inserted the words " not later than one month "
