



# Coast Protection Act 1949

## PART IV

### SUPPLEMENTARY

#### 43 Penalties for offences.

Save as hereinbefore expressly provided, any person committing an offence under any provision of this Act shall be liable on summary conviction, in the case of a first offence under that provision, to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F1</sup>ten pounds][<sup>F1</sup>level 3 on the standard scale] and, in the case of a second or any subsequent offence thereunder, to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F1</sup>fifty pounds][<sup>F1</sup>level 3 on the standard scale].

#### Textual Amendments

- F1** S. 43 for “ten pounds” and “fifty pounds” there is substituted (S.) in each case “level 3 on the standard scale” by virtue of [Criminal Procedure \(Scotland\) Act 1975 \(c. 21, SIF 39:1\)](#), **ss. 289E–289G**
