

Pet Animals Act 1951

1951 CHAPTER 35 14 and 15 Geo 6

2 Pets not to be sold in streets, &c.

If any person carries on a business of selling animals as pets in any part of a $[^{F1}$ street $][^{F1}$ road] or public place, $[^{F2}$ or] at a stall or barrow in a market, he shall be guilty of an offence.
