

Consolidated Fund (Civil List Provisions) Act 1951

1951 CHAPTER 50

An Act to complete the charge on the Consolidated Fund of the provisions made by the Civil List Act, 1937. [1st August 1951]

BE IT ENACTED by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 Charge on the Consolidated Fund.

Section thirteen of the Civil List Act, 1937 (which directs payment out of the Consolidated Fund of the sums required under that Act for the provisions mentioned in that section) shall apply to the sums the payment of which is required by section six of that Act.

2 Short title.

This Act may be cited as the Consolidated Fund (Civil List Provisions) Act, 1951.
