Filling materials within this Act and meaning of "clea"n

33 Filling materials to winch this Act applies

The filling materials to which this Act applies are—

- (a) rag flock,
- (b) unwoven cotton, cotton linters, cotton millpuffs, cotton felt, cotton flock,
- (c) unwoven wool, woollen felt, woollen flock,
- (d) jute,
- (e) unwoven synthetic fibres, synthetic fibre flock,
- (f) hair,
- (g) feathers or down,
- (h) kapok,
- (i) coir fibre, Algerian fibre, Mexican fibre, sisal,
- (j) seaweed, seagrass, Spanish moss,
- (k) straw or chaff,
- (l) such other materials as may be prescribed.

34 Meaning of "clean"

Where standards of cleanliness have been prescribed for any kind of filling materials to which this Act applies, filling materials of that kind shall be treated for the purposes of this Act as clean if, and only if, they comply with the prescribed standards.
