(1) In this Act, except in so far as the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:—
"stream" includes any river, stream, watercourse or inland water (whether natura or artificial), except that it does not include either—  (a) any lake or pond which does not discharge to a stream; or  (b) any sewer vested in a local authority;
or (save as otherwise provided by this Act) any tidal waters, but any reference to a stream includes a reference to the channel or bed of a stream which is for the time being dry;

<ul><li>(6) Nothing contained in this Act shall affect the law relating to nuisance.</li><li>(7) <sup>F2</sup></li></ul>
