ENFORCEMENT OF CERTAIN FOREIGN AWARDS

39 Meaning of “final award”.

For the purposes of this Part of this Act, an award shall not be deemed final if any proceedings for the purpose of contesting the validity of the award are pending in the country in which it was made.
