SIXTH SCHEDULE

PART I

PROVISIONS AS TO JUSTICES' LICENCES IN SUSPENSE BY REASON OF WAR CIRCUMSTANCES.

Appeal to Quarter Sessions.

- 13 The provisions of sections twenty-nine to thirty-two of the Licensing Act as to appeal against a refusal of licensing justices to grant a renewal of a licence shall have effect with the requisite modifications in relation to a refusal of licensing justices to approve plans submitted to them for the purposes of paragraph 2 of this Part of this Schedule, or to signify their satisfaction as to works having been executed in accordance with plans approved, in relation to an order under paragraph 6 thereof, in relation to a refusal of licensing justices to grant an application under paragraph 8 thereof, and in relation to an order under paragraph 9 thereof.
