#### 34 Time for summoning parliament during prorogation.

The date appointed for the meeting of parliament by a proclamation issued under section one of the <sup>M1</sup>Meeting of Parliament Act 1797 (which relates to the summoning of parliament when prorogued), may be any day after the date of the proclamation; . . . . . <sup>F1</sup>
