

Compensation of Displaced Officers (War Service) Act 1945

1945 CHAPTER 10

An Act to provide for the compensation of persons who have been engaged in war service and are not reemployed or suffer loss of employment, reduction of emoluments or deterioration in their conditions, of employment by reason of changes affecting the functions of local or public authorities or public utility undertakers or changes in the management of schools. [7th March 1945.]

BE IT ENACTED by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—
