## 1945 CHAPTER 19 8 and 9 Geo 6

# †Appointment and functions of the Minister of Fuel and Power.

(1) [FIThe Secretary of State] shall be charged with the general duty of securing the effective and co-ordinated development of coal, petroleum and other minerals and sources of fuel and power in Great Britain, . . . F2, and of promoting economy and efficiency in the supply, distribution, use and consumption of fuel and power, whether produced in Great Britain or not.
