(1) This Act may be cited as the Education (Scotland) Act 1945, and the Education (Scotland) Acts 1872 to 1942, the Education (Scotland) (Superannuation) Acts 1919 to 1939, the Educational Endowments (Scotland) Act 1882, the Educational Endowments (Scotland) Acts 1928 to 1935, the Highland Schools Act 1873, and this Act shall be construed as one, and may be cited together as the Education (Scotland) Acts 1872 to 1945.

(3) Save as otherwise expressly provided this Act shall come into operation on the appointed day, and the appointed day shall be such day as the Secretary of State may appoint, and different days may be appointed for different purposes and different provisions of this Act: Provided always that the day appointed for the coming into operation of section twenty-three shall be not later than the first day of April nineteen hundred and forty-six and the day appointed for the coming into operation of sections twenty-nine to thirty-one and eighty-three shall be not later than three years after the date on which the upper limit of the school age is raised to fifteen.

In section twenty-one, in subsection (1), after the words “years” there shall be inserted the words “or any young person who has not attained the age at which under the enactments relating to education children cease to be of school age”, and for the words from “is totally exempted” to the end of the subsection there shall be substituted the words “or young person is not, by being so taken with him, prevented from receiving efficient education suitable to his age, ability and aptitude, be liable on conviction by a court of summary jurisdiction to a fine not exceeding twenty shillings”, and, in subsection (2), after the word “child” in both places where that word occurs there shall be inserted the words “or

The Education (Scotland) (War Service Superannuation) Act, 1939.

In section seven the following definition shall be substituted for, and shall be deemed always to have been, the definition of the expression “period of war service”:—

“Period of war service” in relation to any person includes—

(a) any period during which, though not actually engaged in war service, he is as a result of war service prevented or hindered from procuring work as a teacher; and (b) in the case of a person who, having been admitted or accepted for admission to preliminary training or to a training centre or training college, gives war service before completing his course of training, any period during which, though not actually

engaged in war service, he is as a result of war service prevented or hindered from entering upon or completing his course of training:

Provided that a person's period of war service shall not, by virtue of this definition, be extended by a period or periods exceeding in all one year, or such longer period not exceeding two years as the Secretary of State may in any particular case allow.
