11 Interpretation.

- (1) For the purposes of this Act, any power to make, confirm or approve orders, rules, regulations or other subordinate legislation conferred on the Treasury, . . . ^{F1}, the Board of Trade or any other government department shall be deemed to be conferred on the Minister of the Crown in charge of that department.
- (2) If any question arises whether any board, commissioners or other body on whom any such power as aforesaid is conferred are a government department within the meaning of this section, or what Minister of the Crown is in charge of them, that question shall be referred to and determined by [^{F2}the Minister for the Civil Service].
