

Miscellaneous Financial Provisions Act 1946

1946 CHAPTER 40 9 and 10 Geo 6

An Act to extend the powers of the Treasury to raise money under section one of the National Loans Act 1939, to make provision as to certain obligations arising out of or in connection with the war, to charge certain payments under the War Damage Act 1943, on the Consolidated Fund, to provide for a temporary increase in the capital of the Civil Contingencies Fund, to amend the Defence Loans Act 1937, and to increase the salary of the Comptroller and Auditor-General. [26th March 1946]
