1946 CHAPTER 73 9 and 10 Geo 6

Muirburn (Scotland)

27 [^{F1}Penalties etc. for offences] as to muirburn.

Any person guilty of an offence against section $[^{F2}25 \text{ or } 26(7)]$ of this Act shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding $[^{F3}$ level 3 on the standard scale].
