## SCHEDULE

### OFFENCES REFERRED TO IN S. 3

- 1 In the application of section three of this Act to England and Wales and to Northern Ireland, the expression “offence against the person” means any of the following offences, that is to say:—
- [<sup>F1</sup>(za) [<sup>F2</sup>rape and buggery (offences under the law of Northern Ireland);]]
- (a) murder, manslaughter, <sup>F3</sup>... [<sup>F4</sup>, torture], ... [<sup>F5</sup>robbery] and assault [<sup>F6</sup>and any offence [<sup>F7</sup> under section 2(1) of the Suicide Act 1961 or section 13(1) of the Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 1966 (encouraging or assisting suicide) ]]; and
- (b) any offence not falling within the foregoing sub-paragraph, being an offence punishable under any of the following enactments:—
- (i) the Offences against the <sup>M1</sup>Person Act, 1861, except section fifty-seven thereof (which relates to bigamy);
- <sup>F8</sup>(ii) the <sup>M2</sup>Criminal Law Amendment Act 1885;
- (iii) the <sup>M3</sup>Punishment of Incest Act, 1908;
- (iv) [<sup>F9</sup> ..... <sup>F10</sup> section eighty-nine of the <sup>M4</sup> Mental Health Act (Northern Ireland), 1948 (which relate respectively to certain offences against mentally defective females); ]
- (v) ..... <sup>F11</sup>
- (vi) sections one to five and section eleven of the <sup>M5</sup>Children and Young Persons Act, 1933, and sections eleven, twelve, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen and twenty-one of the <sup>M6</sup>Children and Young Persons Act (Northern Ireland), 1950; and
- (vii) the <sup>M7</sup>Infanticide Act, 1938 and the <sup>M8</sup>Infanticide Act (Northern Ireland), 1939. [<sup>F12</sup>and

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- (i) in the case of a contravention of subsection (2), the act falling within paragraph ( a ) or ( b ) of that subsection would, had it been done, have constituted an offence falling within sub-paragraph ( a ) or ( b ) of this paragraph, or
  - (ii) in the case of a contravention of subsection (3) or (4), the act threatened would, had it been done, have constituted such an offence]
- <sup>F25</sup>[( e ) an offence of making such a threat as is mentioned in section 3 of the United Nations Personnel Act 1997 and any of the following offences against a UN worker within the meaning of that Act—
- (i) an offence of kidnapping;
  - (ii) an offence of false imprisonment;
  - (iii) an offence under section 2 of the Explosive Substances Act 1883 of causing an explosion likely to endanger life.]]
