



Debtors (Scotland) Act 1838

1838 CHAPTER 114

XXV Officer to report Pounding within Eight Days.

And be it enacted, That the Officer shall, within Eight Days after the Day on which the Pounding was executed (unless Cause shall be shown why the same could not be done within the Period of Eight Days), report the Execution thereof to the Sheriff, in which Execution he shall specify the Diligence under which the Pounding is executed, the Amount of the Debt, the Names and Designations of the Debtor and of the Creditor at whose Instance the Effects were pounded, the Effects pounded, the Value thereof, the Names and Designations of the Valutors, the Person in whose Hands they were left, and the Delivery of the Schedule as aforesaid ; which Execution shall be subscribed by him and by the Two Valutors, who shall also be Witnesses to the Pounding, without the Necessity of other Witnesses.
