

Dean Forest (Mines) Act 1838

1838 CHAPTER 43 1 and 2 Vict

LIII †Gaveller and others on behalf of Her Majesty may enter and survey Works.

It shall be lawful . . . ^{F1} for the said Gaveller . . . ^{F1} their or any of their agents, servants, or workmen, at all seasonable times, to enter into and upon any gale, pit, level, work, or quarry now existing, or which may hereafter be opened, made, or worked within the said Hundred, and to inspect the state and workings of every part thereof, and to make a plan thereof; and the owner or occupier of every such gale, pit, level, or work shall furnish . . . ^{F1}, the Gaveller, . . . ^{F1}, with all proper and requisite facilities and information to enable them respectively to perfect such surveys and plans.
