Surveys and Plans

XIV Ordnance may furnish Commissioners with Maps, or cause Surveys to be made.

The principal Officers of Her Majesty's Ordnance may, if they think fit, on the Application of the Commissioners, and at their Expenditure, furnish for the Use of the said Commissioners One or more Copies of any Map of such District, or any Part thereof, which shall have been made under the Direction of the said Ordnance Officers, or may cause a Survey to be made of the said District on a Scale of not less than Sixty Inches to the Mile by surveying Officers appointed by them for such Remuneration as shall previously be agreed upon between the said principal Officers and the Commissioners.
