



Cemeteries Clauses Act 1847

1847 CHAPTER 65

Exclusive Rights of Burial

XLI Plan and Book of Reference to be kept, and be open to Inspection.

The Company shall cause a Plan of the Cemetery to be made upon a Scale sufficiently large to show the Situation of every Burial Place in all the Parts of the Cemetery so set apart, and in which an exclusive Right of Burial has been granted; and all such Burial Places shall be numbered, and such Numbers shall be entered in a Book to be kept for that Purpose, and such Book shall contain the Names and Descriptions of the several Persons to whom the exclusive Right of Burial in any such Place of Burial has been granted by the Company; and no place of burial exclusive Right of Burial therein, shall be made in the Cemetery without the same being marked out in such Plan, and a corresponding Entry made in the said Book, and the said Plan and Book shall be kept by the Clerk of the Company.
