



Cemeteries Clauses Act 1847

1847 CHAPTER 65

Exclusive Rights of Burial

XLVI Assignments to be registered.

Every such Assignment shall, within Six Months after the Execution thereof, if executed *Great Britain or Ireland*, or within Six Months after the Arrival thereof in *Great Britain or Ireland*, if executed elsewhere, be produced to the Clerk of the Company, and an Entry or Memorial of such Assignment shall be made in the Register by the Clerk of the Company, in the same Manner as that of the Original Grant; and until such Entry or Memorial no Right of Burial shall be acquired under any such Memorial; and for every such Entry Or Memorial the Clerk shall be entitled to demand such Sum as the Company think fit, not exceeding the prescribed Sum, or if no Sum be prescribed Two Shillings and Sixpence.
