CHAPTER 30

HARES (SCOTLAND) ACT 1848

Any Person having a Right to kill Hares in Scotland may do so without a Game Certificate, provided they shall be found on his own Land.

- II Such Persons not to be liable to Tax on Game-keepers.
- III To extend to coursing or hunting.
- IV Not to permit the Destruction of Hares, &c. by Poison.
- V Interpretation of Act.
- VI Only to apply to Scotland.
- VII Act may be amended, &c.
