1851 CHAPTER 99 14 and 15 Vict

19 Interpretation of “British Colony.”

The words “British Colony” as used in this Act shall apply . . . ^{F1} to the islands of Guernsey, Jersey, Alderney, Sark, and Man, and to all other possessions of the British Crown, wheresoever and whatsoever.
