CLXXWant of Certainty cured by Particulars.

Want of "reasonable Certainty" in the Description of the Property, or Part of it, in the Writ or Notice, shall not nullify them, but shall only be Ground for an' Application to a Judge for better Particulars of the Land claimed or defended, which a Judge shall have Power to give in all Cases.
