Proceedings to revive

CXXXI Writs of Scire facias in other Cases to be tested, directed, and proceeded upon in like Manner.

All Writs of Scire facias issued out of any of the Superior Courts of Law at *Westminster* against Bail on a Recognizance ; Ad audiendum errores ; against Members of a Joint Stock Company or other Body, upon a Judgment recorded against a public Officer or other Person sued as representing such Company or Body, or against such Company or Body itself ; by or against a Husband to have Execution of a Judgment for or against a Wife ; for Restitution after a Reversal in Error ; upon a Suggestion of further Breaches after Judgment for any Penal Sum, pursuant to the Statute passed in the Session holden in the Eighth and Ninth Years of the Reign of King *William* the Third, intituled *An Act for the better preventing frivolous and vexatious Suits*; or for Recovery of Land taken under an Elegit, shall be tested, directed, and proceeded upon, in like Manner as Writs of Revivor.
