Pleadings

LXXI Payment into Court how pleaded.

When Money is paid into Court, such Payment shall be pleaded in all Cases, as near as may be, in the following Form, mutatis mutandis:

The Defendant by his Attorney [or in Person, & c.] [if pleaded to part say, as to \mathscr{L} Parcel of the Money claimed], brings into Court the Sum of \mathscr{L} and says that the said Sum is enough to satisfy the Claim of the Plaintiff in respect of the Matter herein pleaded to.
