Pleadings

LXXIX Joinder of Issue.

Either Party may plead, in answer to the Plea or subsequent Pleading of his Adversary, that he joins Issue thereon, which Joinder of Issue may be as follows, or to the like Effect:

“The Plaintiff joins Issue upon the Defendant's 1st [*&c., specifying " what or what Part]* Plea :”

“The Defendant joins Issue upon the Plaintiff's Replication to the " 1st [*&c., specifying what]* Plea ;”
