Pleadings

LXXXVIII ~~as~~ **not to be repeated.**

No Plea, which has already been pleaded to the Declaration, shall be pleaded to such new Assignment, except' a Plea in Denial, unless by Leave of the Court or a Judge; and such Leave shall only be granted upon satisfactory Proof that the Repetition of such Plea is essential to a Trial on the Merits.
